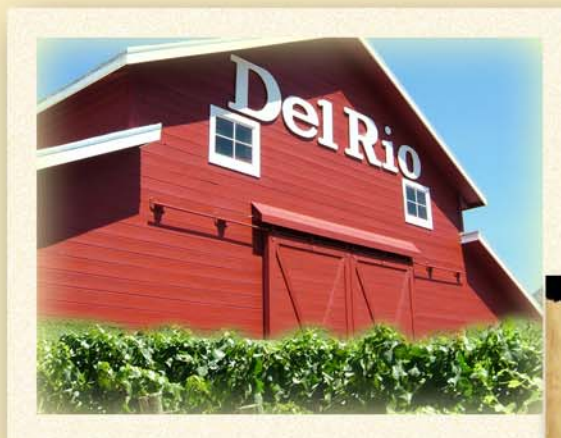


2009 DEL RIO CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Notable Cabernet Sauvignon

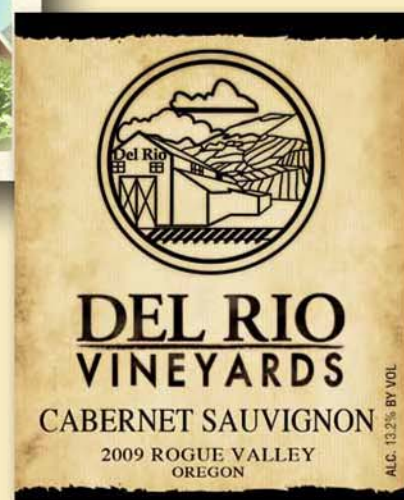
VINEYARD

WINEMAKING

100% Cabernet Sauvignon.
Aged in 30% new oak. 1/3 American oak and 2/3 French oak.

TASTING NOTES

The 2009 Cabernet Sauvignon is an elegant wine: with your first impression embracing the light hint of oak, providing aromas of vanilla and sweet wood. The palate offers bright flavors of cherry and black currant. A rounded-mouth feel awards the wine a delicious conclusion. With the young tannic structure the 2009 Cabernet Sauvignon shines with great potential for aging.



VINTAGE NOTES - 2009

The midsummer's heat wave really accelerated the sugar development of the 2009 vintage and resulted in an early start of harvest. The dry harvest gave way to cooler than expected conditions in late September, delaying the picking of our reds. Fortunately, the majority of the fruit was already near to full ripening, which led to fruity well-balanced white wines and structured reds.

FOOD PAIRING

Pair with steak or dishes with heavy butter cream sauce. We also recommend a variety of cheeses, such as cheddar, mozzarella & brie. Even bitter dark chocolate will marry well with it. Enjoy now or cellar for the next 4-6 years.
