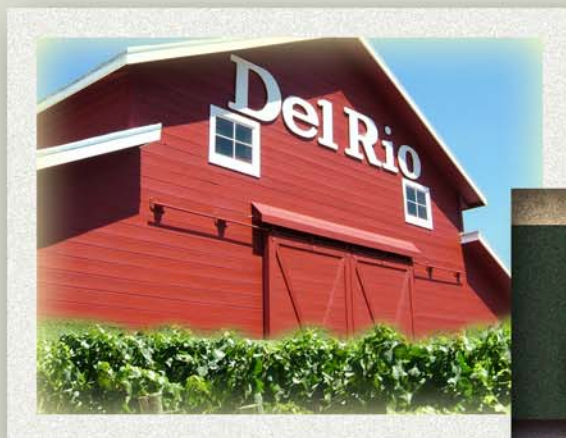


2005 DEL RIO CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Notable Cabernet Sauvignon

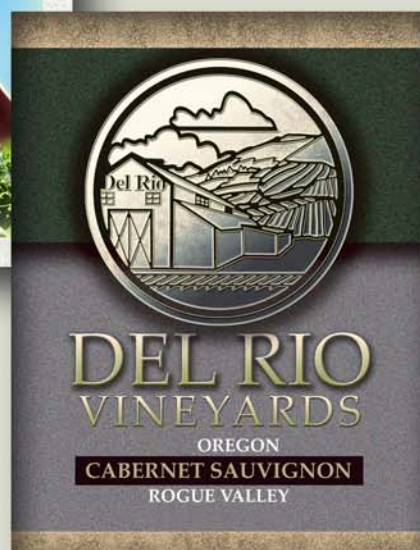
VINEYARD

Del Rio Vineyards is located at the 42.43° latitude in the Rogue Valley Appellation of Southern Oregon.

80% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Cabernet Franc, and 10% Merlot.

TASTING NOTES

Our 100% Estate grown Cabernet Sauvignon has deep color with aromas of blackberry, mocha, bell pepper, and cedar. A friendly full-bodied structure carries flavors of plum, currant, vanilla, and pepper. The finish is medium to long, riding on the nicely present acid and soft ripe tannins. Balance wise, the fruit is well integrated with oak.



VINTAGE NOTES - 2005

This year's Oregon grape harvest occurred later than most expected, resulting in cooler temperatures, lower alcohol levels, structured acidity and ideal flavor development resulting in excellent quality

FOOD PAIRING

Pair with steak or dishes with heavy butter cream sauce. We also recommend a variety of cheeses, such as cheddar, mozzarella & brie. Even bitter dark chocolate will marry well with it. Enjoy now or cellar for the next 4-6 years.
