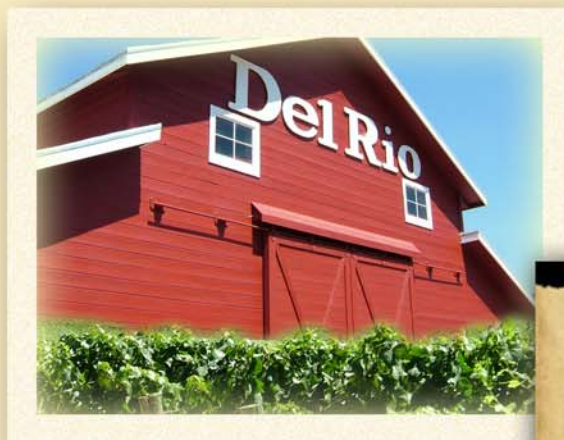


# 2007 DEL RIO CABERNET SAUVIGNON

## WINEMAKING

This wine underwent five days of cold soak and aged 18 months in barrels. 64% was in French oak, 24% in American and 12% Hungarian oak.

## TASTING NOTES

Our 100% Estate grown Cabernet Sauvignon has a deep black currant color. Aromas of prune, raisin and smoked oak, with a touch of licorice notes. On the palate, this full bodied wine is well balanced, with good acidity and young tannins, showing its aging potential.



## VINTAGE NOTES - 2007

Benefitting from a late harvest the grapes experienced much cooler temperatures, lower alcohol levels, structured acidity and ideal flavor development. 2007 was indeed an excellent vintage.

## FOOD PAIRING

Pair with steak or dishes with heavy butter cream sauce. We also recommend a variety of cheeses, such as cheddar, mozzarella & brie. Even bitter dark chocolate will marry well with it. Enjoy now or cellar for the next 4-6 years.
