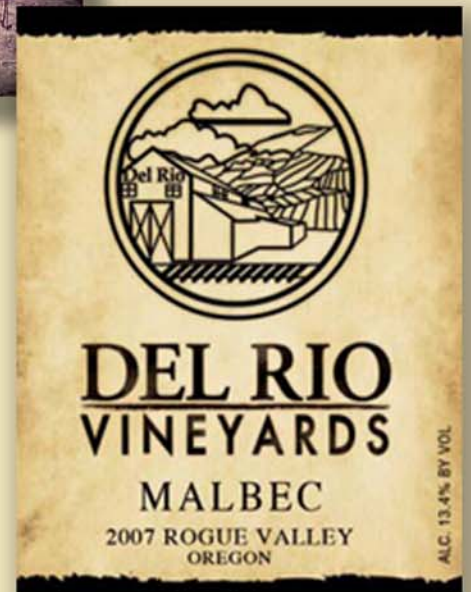
at 1089 Vines per acre. This is a wonderful site for Malbec
