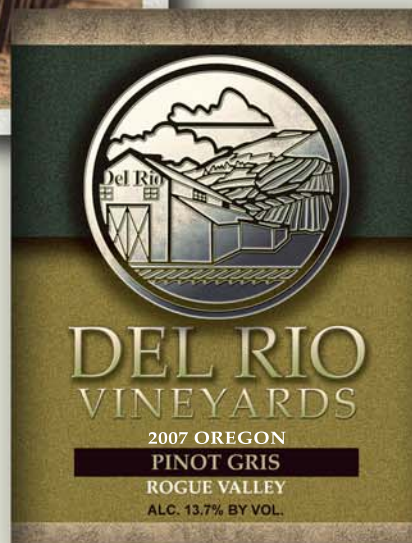
VINEYARD

The 2007 Del Rio Pinot Gris is sourced entirely from Del Rio Vineyards in the Rogue Valley

Appellation of Southern Oregon. 16 acres of vines on clones 146 and 152. Vines are planted to 1089 vines per acre. The warm summer days and cool nights allow the fruit to ripen slowly and develop extraordinary fruit flavors.



CROP YIELD

Average 3.95 tons per acre

WINEMAKING

Fermented 87% in stainless steel and 13% in 4 year old neutral French barrels. Stirred for three months in tank to add to the structure and mouthfeel. The wine was then fined with both, bentonite and then crossflow filtered and bottled.

This 2007 Pinot Gris will dazzle your taste buds with the fruit flavors of pear, apple, and aromas of wildflower honey. The concentration of fruit and crisp acidity create a mouth watering sensation. This spicy and aromatic wine is sure to delight all your taste buds.



VINTAGE NOTES - 2007

Benefitting from a late harvest the grapes experienced much cooler temperatures, lower alcohol levels, structured acidity and ideal flavor development. 2007 was indeed an excellent vintage.
