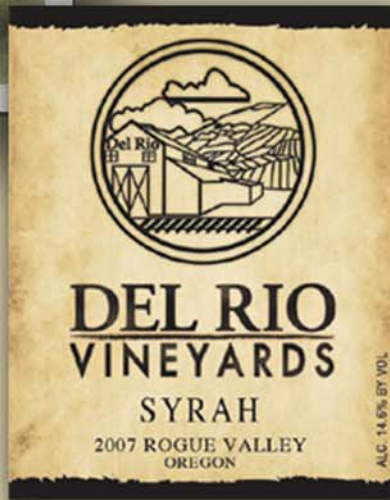

## WINEMAKING

This wine underwent five days of cold soak. Barrel aged 18 months in 90% oak (of which 35% was new French oak) and the remaining 10% was aged in stainless steel tanks.

## STATISTICS

Alcohol - 14.6%  
Acidity - 5.7 g/L  
R/S - .2%

## TASTING NOTES

The nose of the Syrah is a mixture of black currant, bay leaf and thyme. Aged 35% in new oak, the smokey mouth gives way to an intense spicy black pepper finish.



## VINTAGE NOTES - 2007

Benefitting from a late harvest the grapes experienced much cooler temperatures, lower alcohol levels, structured acidity and ideal flavor development. 2007 was indeed an excellent vintage..

## FOOD PAIRING

Pair with beef, lamb, and game or blackened meaty fish such as salmon and tuna. We also recommend a variety of cheeses, such as cheddar, goat, aged gouda, gruyere, and camembert. Enjoy it now or cellar for up to 5 years.
